## **puraDYN Order Backlog and Shipments Exceed \$750,000 to Set New Pace for 2003**

Kroger, President and COO, said, “The **puraDYN** system specified by a major generator set manufacturer, as announced earlier this year, as well as our strategic alliance with Honeywell Consumer Products Group (CPG), manufacturer of FRAM<sup>®</sup> filtration products, announced late last year, have both helped set the pace for a record level of orders and shipments in January and the beginning of February. Our alliance with Honeywell CPG, which includes a three-year supply agreement, has led to the manufacturing of a co-branded FRAM<sup>®</sup> and **puraDYN**<sup>®</sup> bypass oil filtration system.”

Kroger continued, “Additionally, our record-setting orders and shipments in 2003 to date are also due in large part to our continuing strategy to focus on developing and expanding our aftermarket programs with Volvo Trucks North America, Mack Trucks, Peterbilt and Kenworth Trucks; our domestic and international distributor network which has grown 13-fold since 2001; and our relationships with key medium- and large-size fleets, including one of the largest private fleets in the US.”
